WH- = a question word


1) With BE

3rd person	Present simple	Past simple
singular	WH- is ... ?	WH- was ... ?
plural	WH- are ... ?	WH- were ... ?

2) With OTHER verbs than BE

V = infinitive form of a verb

3rd person	Present simple	Past simple
singular	WH- does S + V ?	WH- did S + V ?
plural	WH- do S + V ?	

	WHO, WHAT, HOW MANY = subject of the question
Present simple	Who likes s ... ? What happens s when you press that button? How many people speak more than 10 languages? (How many + plural)
Past simple	Who discovered ed ... ? Who wrote ... ? What forced ed people to leave the country? How many people died ed ? How many people left the country?
